	<p>City of Chicago, Foodservice Manager Certificate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Located in Chicago? This certificate is a business license requirement. • You must have one Certified Manager on site at all times. • 5-year certificate term; need to take one-day class and pass exam. 	<p>State of Illinois, Foodservice Sanitation Manager Certificate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who needs it? Shared Kitchen users, Wholesalers (Chicago restaurants <i>do not</i> need this certificate) • You must have one Certified Manager on site during production at all times • 5-year certificate term; need to take one-day class and pass exam. 	<p>Illinois Safe Food Handler</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who needs it? Anyone working with food that is not a certified manager. • 3-year certificate term; online class and exam, about 1.5 hours • Take class on your pc, tablet or phone here: http://logansquarekitchen.com/handler/ • There are many training companies; just be sure class is ANSI accredited, like the symbol here
	<p>City of Chicago Festival Certificate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparing food at temporary outdoor events? Must have at least one Festival Certificate Holder on site • One-year term, expires March each year • 2.5-hour class, no exam • NO, you do not have to be a Food Safety Manger; anyone is eligible for this certificate • NO, Food Manager or Food Handler certificates do not substitute for this certificate
